



Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Services Community Programs - Pennsylvania

Description

KidsPeace Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Services provides clinical services to children and adolescents who have an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) diagnosis. Services are provided to children and their families to assist them in developing new skills and coping mechanisms.

Population Served

The program serves males and females from birth to age 21 with autism.

Services

Services are provided to both the child and his or her caretakers. Families are expected to be active participants in the treatment process. Services are child-centered and family focused. Services involve the family in all decisions regarding treatment.

Treatment Team

Child-centered, family-focused treatment plans are developed with input from the child, the parents and other care providers working with the family and KidsPeace. Guidance counselors and teachers may participate when services are provided in the school setting. The treatment team may be composed of, but is not limited to, the following:

- The client and his or her family
- Licensed psychologists
- Doctoral and Master's level behavioral specialists
- Bachelor's level therapeutic staff support workers
- Bachelor's level case managers
- Collaborative agencies.

Treatment Locations

Services are provided in the child's home, school, daycare center or community.

Hours of Operation

This service can be provided to the client during times and on days most convenient in order to meet treatment needs; therefore, hours are scheduled by the client and the therapist as needed.
